

729th Session
Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors
February 5, 2013

The scheduled meeting of February 5, 2013 was held at the Board Office, 165 Capitol Avenue, Room 117 in the State Office Building, Hartford, Connecticut.

Anthony L D'Andrea, Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:22 am.

Motion made by (5) seconded by (1) to approve the January 2013 minutes. Motion carried.

Legal Division

Attorney Steven Schwane filed a memo with the Board concerning his investigation of the October 2012 Irregularity Report from NCEES and would like the Board to vote on this issue. (Dist 2)

The report indicated that two examinees had a high percentage of identical correct and incorrect answers. Attorney Schwane met with both individuals concerning the NCEES report, where both candidates cooperated fully and answered questions under oath. Their answers were consistent and other than statistical similarity in their answers, no evidence of collusion or copying was found.

Motion made by (8) seconded by (3) to recommend that the department notify NCEES of this finding and that NCEES release the scores of these two candidates.

A-2 Memorandum from NCEES dated 1/22/13: Re Notice of Initiation of Computer-Based Testing. (Dist. 4)

Memorandum provided the information in regards to the conversion of the FE and FS exams. It also provided the two options that are available to register candidates for these exams.

Option 1: Automatic- Examinees will be required to attest to the following statement: “Passage of the FE/FS exam alone does not ensure certification as an engineer/surveyor intern or engineer/surveyor-in-training in any US state or territory. To obtain certification, you must file an application with an engineering/surveying licensing board and meet the board’s requirements.”

Once examinees attest to this statement, they are automatically approved to take the exam. Examinees are notified directly of their results and can typically log in to retrieve them within 48 hours of taking the exam. When a board receives an application for intern certification, the board would then verify the FE/FS results.

Option 2: Manual-The Board must manually approve examinees for each exam attempt. Once approved by the board, examinees register with NCEES. Results can be released to boards or directly to the examinees, typically within 48 hours.

The Board held a discussion as to which option they would like to take and the consensus of the Board was with Option 1:

C-Old Business

C-1 Corporate Chart- (Dist. 4)

Assistant Attorney Peter Huntsman provided the Board with an updated corporate chart which included the landscape architects. Attorney Huntsman will add footnotes to the chart forward the revised chart to the Board.

D- New Business

The Board administrator advised the board that she was in attendance at a meeting of the department's interpretation of section 20-300-11 which was as follows:

- 1) Licenses that expire from 1 to 5 years must pay all back fees
- 2) After 5 years the individual loses the automatic right to renewal - a new application is to be filed and must be consistent with the standards at that time of application with just an application fee.

The department is taking the position of licenses that expire 1-5 years must pay all back fees to reinstate their licenses; and after 5 years an individual must complete a new application, pay one application fee and keep the same license number. However, the Board will determine if the individual meets the criteria for licensure that is consistent with the Board. The Board shall determine whether or not the experience during the lapsed period is satisfactory to the Board.
